ABOUT BABA GURU NANAK UNIVERSITY NANKANA SAHIB

Baba Guru Nanak University (BGNU) is a public sector university located in District Nankana Sahib, in the Punjab region of Pakistan. It plans to facilitate between 10,000 to 15,000 students from all over the world at the university. The foundation stone of the university was laid on October 28, 2019 ahead of 550th of Guru Nanak Gurpurab by the Prime Minister of Pakistan. On July, 02, 2020 Government of Punjab has formally passed Baba Guru Nanak University Nankana Sahib Act 2020 (X of 2020).

The plan behind the establishment of this university to be modeled along the lines of world-renowned universities with focus on languages and Punjab Studies offering faculties in "Medicine", "Pharmacy", "Engineering", "Computer science", "Languages", "Music" and "Social sciences". The initial cost Rupees 6 billion has already been allocated in the budget for this project to be spent in three phases on construction of Baba Guru Nanak University Nankana Sahib. The development work of Phase-I has already been started by Communication and Works Department of Government of Punjab.



APPOINTMENT AND TENURE OF PROF. DR. MUHAMMAD AFZAL

Prof. Dr. Muhammad Afzal was appointed as the Founding Vice Chancellor of Baba Guru Nanak University (BGNU), Nankana Sahib, through notification issued by the Higher Education Department (HED), Government of Punjab, dated March 2, 2021. He formally assumed office as Vice Chancellor of BGNU on March 4, 2021, at a time when the university existed solely as a legislative entity, with no physical infrastructure, faculty, administrative staff, or academic programs in place.

MEETINGS OF STATUTORY BODIES

Meetings of Finance & Planning Committee

The Finance and Planning Committee held its 4th meeting on July 5, 2024, at the University of Education, Lahore, under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Muhammad Afzal. Key agenda items included approving salary increases for university employees in accordance with the Punjab Government's FY-2024-25 budget, ensuring fair compensation amid rising living costs. The committee also sanctioned the commencement of short courses, expanding academic offerings for professional skill development. Additionally, the BGNU Need-Based Scholarship Regulations were approved, providing financial assistance to deserving students from underprivileged backgrounds. These decisions collectively reinforced BGNU's commitment to both its employees and students, fostering a supportive and progressive educational environment.





Meetings of Academic Council

The Academic Council, which met for the first time on January 28, 2025, played a crucial role in defining BGNU's academic framework. It approved key regulatory documents, including the university's admission policy, semester regulations, and student conduct guidelines, ensuring a structured approach to academic governance. The council also adopted HEC's updated curriculum guidelines for undergraduate and graduate programs, aligning BGNU with national academic standards. Notably, the council approved new academic programs in Data Science, Climate Studies, and Economics, responding to market demands and societal needs. Additionally, an International Advisory Board was formed to enhance BGNU's global academic standing, while partnerships with organizations such as the Rekhi Foundation were formalized to promote student welfare and mental health initiatives.





Meetings of Board of Faculties

The Boards of Faculties held their inaugural meetings in 2024, covering five key academic divisions: Natural Sciences & Technology, Theology & Religion, Management Sciences, Social & Behavioral Sciences, and Languages & Liberal Arts. These meetings focused on curriculum development, expert consultations, and policy recommendations. Across faculties, special emphasis was placed on integrating Pakistan Studies and Seerat-un-Nabi courses, ensuring a holistic approach to education. In addition, the Faculty of Management Sciences and the Faculty of Social & Behavioral Sciences recommended the inclusion of Islamic finance and translation of the Holy Quran within their respective programs. These decisions reflect BGNU's dedication to cultural, ethical, and professional education.







Meetings of Selection Board

Faculty and staff recruitment remained a top priority, with the Selection Board holding four key meetings to evaluate candidates for academic and administrative positions. The 3rd meeting from September 4-6, 2023, at the University of Education, Lahore, focused on hiring Assistant Professors and Lecturers across disciplines such as Management Sciences, Punjabi, Fine Arts, and Physics. The 4th meeting from September 20-26, 2023, evaluated candidates for Mathematics, Botany, IT & Computer Science, Psychology, Islamic Studies, English, and Chemistry. The 5th meeting on April 6, 2024, appointed senior faculty members, including Professors and Associate Professors, reinforcing BGNU's academic strength. The 6th meeting on May 2, 2024, extended hiring to non-teaching staff, including Assistant Directors, Network Administrators, and Personal Secretaries, ensuring administrative efficiency.





Meetings of Selection Committee

In parallel, the Selection Committee convened four times to recruit essential university staff. The 3rd meeting from March 15-18, 2024, appointed Security Guards, Computer Lab Attendants, Computer Technicians, Store Keepers, and Junior Clerks, supporting campus security and operations. The 4th meeting on April 5, 2024, filled roles such as Electricians, Cooks, and Drivers, ensuring the university's infrastructure and transport services remained fully operational. The 5th meeting on May 24, 2024, recruited Sub Engineers (Civil and Electrical), a Deputy Estate Officer, and a Media Coordinator, reinforcing the university's technical and media outreach capabilities. The 6th meeting on August 29-30, 2024, focused on hiring support staff, including Naib Qasids, Mali, Bus Conductors, and Sweepers, contributing to the overall maintenance and smooth functioning of university operations. The 7th Selection Committee meeting, held on February 28, 2024, focused on recruitment of bus drivers.

Through these systematic advancements, BGNU has established itself as a progressive and well-managed institution, ensuring academic integrity, financial sustainability, and institutional excellence. DATABASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The database is very crucial for the University record maintenance. It helps to maintain the credibility of data and track the changes in the record if any. The records of admissions applicants and BGNU students are also saved in the database. Key features of the database are as follows:

a. Database Designing

Database designing involves creating a detailed data model that defines the structure of a database, including tables, relationships, constraints, and indexes. It ensures data integrity and supports efficient queries. A well-designed database optimizes storage, minimizes redundancy, and allows for scalability as data grows.

b. Database Security

Database security focuses on protecting the database from unauthorized access, breaches, and attacks. It involves implementing encryption, access controls, user authentication, and auditing mechanisms. Ensuring secure data storage, transmission, and regular backups are critical aspects to prevent data loss or manipulation.

c. Database Accessibility

Database accessibility ensures that authorized users can access data in a timely and efficient manner. This includes designing systems that are compatible with various platforms, allowing seamless access for users, and ensuring high availability through redundancy and fail over solutions to minimize downtime.

d. Database Monitoring

Database monitoring involves continuously tracking database performance, health, and usage metrics. It helps identify potential issues such as slow queries, resource bottlenecks, or security vulnerabilities. Monitoring tools can provide alerts and reports, enabling proactive maintenance and troubleshooting.

e. Capacity Planning

Capacity planning involves estimating future database resource needs, such as storage, processing power, and memory, to handle the expected growth in data volume and user demand. It ensures that the database infrastructure scales appropriately and avoids performance degradation or outages as demand increases.

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

From 3rd semester for session, fall of 2022-2026, the Directorate of IT has implemented the CMS software for the students and faculty of the university. The software Engineer and his team worked with the exam department to develop the system as per the requirements. The exam portal has the following list of features:

RESULT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The result management system helps the exam department to cross-validate the marks of the students, submitted by the faculty member. This creates a check before the result is displayed. It also helped the exam department to make their examination record accurate and reliable. Students can view their results in their CMS portal. A grade book category is added to their portals. Examinations' attendance sheets are printed with students' details automatically from the database.

COURSES MANAGEMENT & ENROLLMENT

Course management and enrollment systems are also handed over to the exam department. It facilitates them to enroll in new courses, and add & drop students in them.

IMPLEMENTATION OF BIOMETRIC ATTENDANCE

In a significant step towards enhancing efficiency and accountability, BGNU successfully implemented a biometric attendance system for all staff and faculty members. This modern technology, which utilizes face recognition, ensures accurate and timely tracking of attendance records. By eliminating the potential for manual errors and providing real-time data, the biometric system has streamlined administrative processes, improved attendance compliance, and fostered a more transparent and accountable work environment.

Expansion of Library Holdings: A Remarkable Growth Trajectory

Through strategic acquisitions, institutional collaborations, and generous contributions from various sources, the library has expanded its holdings to cater to the diverse academic needs of students and faculty members.

- The library's purchased collection has expanded from 309 titles to 606 titles, with 1,158 copies of these books available. Additionally, through active engagement with donors and academic institutions, the total number of books—including those obtained through donations and gifts—has reached nearly 2,500 volumes across multiple disciplines.
- Recognizing the need for a modernized approach to research and knowledge acquisition, Prof. Dr. Afzal spearheaded the addition of over 50,000 digital resources. This extensive e-library has enabled students and faculty to access scholarly materials beyond the limitations of physical books, ensuring a seamless research experience.

Infrastructure Development and Technological Integration

In line with global trends in academic resource management, the modernization of library infrastructure was a key priority under Prof. Dr. Afzal's leadership. Several initiatives were undertaken to enhance research capabilities, digital access, and overall functionality, including:

- Recognizing the need for a dedicated study and research environment, a specialized faculty workspace has been established within the library. This area is designed to support faculty members in their research endeavors, fostering academic collaboration and scholarly productivity.
- The integration of a modernized library management system has been a game-changer in ensuring efficient cataloging, tracking, and accessibility of books. With over 2,000+ new book entries, the system now reflects emerging academic trends and enhances ease of access for students and faculty.

Enhancing the Reading Culture and Research Engagement

Prof. Dr. Afzal has played an instrumental role in promoting a culture of reading, research, and intellectual discourse at BGNU. His efforts have made the library a vibrant center of learning, offering resources and services tailored to meet the needs of an evolving academic community.

- A wide range of daily newspapers (Dawn, Khabrain, and Nawa-e-Waqt), magazines, and academic journals in both English and Urdu are now available in the library. This expansion allows students and researchers to stay updated with current affairs, academic developments, and subject-specific advancements.
- To facilitate greater engagement with library resources, the book loan policy has been improved, allowing faculty and students to borrow books for up to 15 days. Over 200 books have been issued and returned under this new streamlined system, reflecting increased usage and accessibility.


